TERMS of GRATUITOUS PERFORMANCE LICENSE of SACRED MUSIC

Please read this Performance License carefully and keep this copy for your records.

Your signature on the acceptance line of the **Performance Contract** affirms that you have read and accept the terms, conditions and provisions set forth below.

TERMS OF LICENSE – Any violation of these provisions shall automatically terminate this License and all rights and privileges of music performance of the specified work.

1. Rights Granted

a. This License allows the public performance of the titled work under the following terms and conditions for a period of two years from the date of contract, and can be renewed for consecutive years upon request.

2. Revisions, Alterations, or Arrangements: Any alterations or changes are strictly prohibited, including but not limited to the following:

a. You may not add new music, dialogue, lyrics, or anything else to the text of the work.

b. You may not delete, in whole or in part, any material in the existing work without the written permission of Francis Koerber. All requests must be submitted in writing.

c. You may not make changes of any kind, including but not limited to changes of music, lyrics or arrangements in the presentation or performance of this work.

3. You may make a limited number of copies of the licensed work

a. All prints and copies must bear the copyright notice and be affixed in full, clearly and legible at the bottom of each copy of this work including the licensing information and any other text that is included by the author.

b. one (1) copy for each member of your ensemble for the express purpose of performing this work at your church liturgy. It may not be altered, amended, or changed in any way, electronically or by any other means.

4. This work cannot be transferred to any other organization, or person for any reason whatsoever. If this is violated, the license is immediately null and void.

5. Recording/Reproduction (Audio, Video, Computer Sequencing, etc.)

a. This license does not allow you to make and/or distribute a mechanical or a digital recording (rehearsal or performance) of the work or any portion of it by any means whatsoever, including, but not limited to, audiocassette, video, film, digital audio, etc.

You may however, make 1 (one) archival recording of the work, with the agreement that it will not be distributed or sold in any way to the public through any means, whatsoever. The composer also requests an mp3 file of the recorded production to be used in the further promotion of this work.

b. Broadcast: This license does not allow you to broadcast, televise and/or electronically post on the Internet any part of the work, either audio or visual or both.

6. Program/Poster/Advertising Credits

a. The Licensee agrees to credit the composer in any program associated with performance if one is created.
